

KA School Bus Safety Tips 2014-15

Riding a school bus can be fun if you follow the school bus safety rules!!



Safety rules to follow when waiting for the school bus:

- Always wait for the school bus at the school bus stop. Never wait for the school bus from inside your house.
- Always arrive at the school bus stop early so that you don't have to rush.
- 3. Always wait for the school bus on the sidewalk. Do not stand, run, or play in the street.
- 4. When the bus approaches stand at least 2 giants steps away from the curb or the edge of the road.
- 5. Wait in a line away from the street.
- 6. Do not push or shove anyone while waiting for the bus.

Safety rules to follow when getting on the school bus:

- 1. Wait until the bus stops, the door opens, and the driver says that it is okay before stepping on the bus.
- 2. Stay in a straight line while getting on the school bus.
- 3. Do not push or shove anyone while getting on the bus.
- 4. Hold on to the handrail when getting on the school bus.

Safety rules to follow when riding the school bus:

- 1. When riding the school remain in your seat.
- 2.
- 3. Sit with your feet in front of your seat. Do not sit with your feet in the aisle. You could accidentally make someone fall.
- 4. Don't talk loudly or yell or scream. If you have to talk, do it softly.
- 5. Do not put hands, feet, or any other part of your body outside the school bus window.
- 6. Don't eat or drink while riding the school bus. You could choke or spill your food.

Safety rules to follow while getting off the school bus:

- 1. The students in the front of the bus should get off first.
- 2. When getting off the schoolbus, stay in a straight line.
- 3. Always hold on to the handrail, while getting of the bus.
