## Australia's Wildfires

This year's fire season in Australia has been amplified. This season has seen the worst fires in decades. The fire season began in late July but is expected to continue until January or February. So far 28 people are dead nationwide, and more than 3000 homes have been damaged or destroyed. The fires have been said to have been exacerbated by persistent heat and drought conditions.

There have been fires in every Australian state, but New South Wales has been hit the hardest. The Australian fires have mostly been started by natural causes like lightning strikes in drought affected areas, but humans could also be blamed. There have been 24 people charged with deliberately starting bushfires.

Experts say that climate change has worsened the impact of natural disasters. Entire towns have been engulfed by fire. The heaviest structural damage was in New South Wales, where 1558 homes were destroyed and over 650 damaged. More than 17.9 million acres of land have been burned across the states. About half a million animals have been affected by these wildfires. An estimated one million are dead, but could be as high as one billion. One third of koalas have been killed due to these fires. More than 2000 firefighters are working on ground in NSW alone.

Australia is only about halfway through the fierce season, and the temperatures are expected to peak in January and February. The fires are unlikely to ever be completely put out because of the annual occurrence.

The things you will need for the heart pendant are colored construction paper, a hot glue gun, hot glue sticks, a chain, a heart stencil, scissors, and a pencil. First take the stencil and trace it with a pencil on colored construction paper. Next put hot glue all in the heart stencil then cut it out and put a hole in the top for the chain. Then put the chain through the hole and clasp it around your neck.

The next craft is the chocolate bowls. You will only need a few items for the bowls. Gather together balloons, chocolate, bowls and some valentines sprinkles if you have them. The first step is to blow up the balloon and knot it. Then melt the chocolate either over a double boiler or in the microwave until melted mixing in 15 second intervals. After melted, dip the bottom of the balloon and add sprinkles if wanted. Next put the top of the balloon in the bowl then put it in the fridge. It is a brain related condition that may run in families, but scientists haven't been able to prove it yet. Having dyscalculia doesn't mean that you can't do math. # Tension between Iran and the US

U.S. officials told the Associated Press that the American military was not responsible for this attack. Since then, tension has weakened between the two countries.

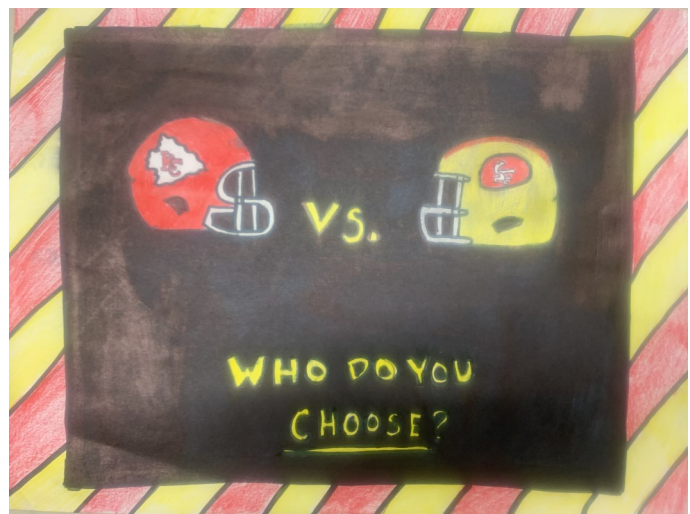
