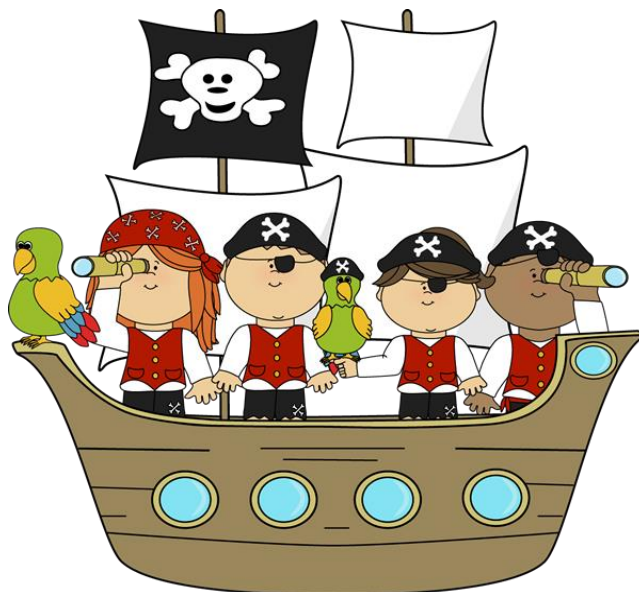
The 1st Kindergarten Academy Orientation will be Friday, June 7, 2019 for students registered by May 24, 2019.
