Looking for individualized attention? We can offer that for you. We have a Cyber Education Facilitator that is available daily to assist you with accessing your courses, organizational skills, time management, and overall guidance through your journey in cyber education. We also have Interboro teachers available in the Cyber Café for tutoring, a dedicated guidance counselor and case manager for students requiring special education services.

Are you looking for something different to meet your instructional needs? We can do that. Interboro School District offers both full cyber and blended options. This means you can come into school as needed for assistance to work on your online courses. You can also take some courses online while taking others in our school buildings. Some students may also be eligible to take courses through the Delaware County Technical Schools program.

Looking for course variety? We can offer that too! The Interboro School District has been working to update their curriculum to offer additional elective courses such as Media Production and Computer Science as well as incorporating updated technology throughout the buildings. We also partner with online providers to offer more courses online for our cyber students.

Need a flexible schedule? We can meet that need! Our online program offers asynchronous classes which means we do not require a specific time schedule for course meetings. It is recommended that you create a schedule; however, teachers offer virtual office hours for you to contact them as needed throughout the day. We look for progress and completion in coursework.

How much time should I spend on my classes? It is recommended to spend at least one hour per day for each course.

Are you taking PSSA or Keystone Exams? No problem, we will make arrangements for you to come to one of our district buildings to complete the assessments. No out of district traveling required.

No available technology? No problem. We provide the laptop you need to meet the academic requirements of the program. In addition, you can receive a reimbursement for internet access.
