Registration Process

Complete the Interboro Early Learning Academy Application Form and Process by:

Pre-Application

- 1. Complete the Interboro Early Learning Academy Application Form
- 2. Pre-register to show proof of residency within the Interboro School District
- 3. Provide documentation that your family income is at or below 300 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Income verification is required.

Full Application Process (to be completed after pre-application)

- 1. Complete the Interboro School District registration packet per District policy
- 2. Provide additional information to finalize eligibility
- 3. Complete the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) form for free and reduced meal reimbursement

Morning PreK

- Monday through Friday, 8:30-11:30 AM
- Breakfast will be served each morning

Afternoon PreK

- Class will be held Monday through Thursday, 12:30-3:00 PM (except the last Wednesday of each month due to the District professional development schedule)
- Snack will be served each afternoon.

Location - Interboro High School (transportation will NOT be available at this time)
