Financial Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration for a slot in the PreK Counts program, the child's family income must be at or below 300% of federal poverty level (required risk factory). To determine if your family is eligible, consider size of the child's household (defined below) and all sources of income. See Federal Poverty Level Guidelines to family size.

All documentation must be provided at the time of the application appointment. It will be verified by the Interboro SD Business Office.

^{*}Note: If a family is at or below 100% of federal poverty level, the child is eligible for PreK Counts but may also be eligible for Head Start. Head Start may better serve the needs of some children and families due to the additional services they can offer. Interboro SD does not have any HeadStart classrooms in the District.
