Senior Timeline -

May 1st – Prom Tickets go on sale – Each ticket will cost \$25. Students will need to complete a PINK Prom form before they can purchase a ticket. This form needs to be signed and all account balances need to be closed before tickets can be purchased.

May 6th is the LAST DAY to purchase a yearbook. Books can be purchased at <u>https://www.yearbookordercenter.com/</u> and enter order number 21377. From there, you can select your student and complete the purchase. LIMITED copies may be available for cash sales after the pre-orders are distributed in June, but there is no guarantee. May 12th – Last Day to purchase a PROM TICKET

- Seniors will be dismissed after a brief meeting at 10 AM.
- All those attending the prom must be in school in order to attend prom that night.
- All seniors will be dismissed by 10:30 AM regardless if they are going to the prom.
- Underclassmen attending prom as dates must also be in school and will be dismissed at 10:30 AM.
- All Seniors are off on Friday.

June 6th– Full Class Day - Senior Grades Close at 3:00 PM.

- Seniors not graduating will be notified by the end of the day Summer School information will be distributed. Students report for a full day of classes.

June 7th – Students report 7:40 AM – 10:30 AM – report to the Auditorium

- Collection of all Interboro Technology & locker clean out Seniors need to turn in their school issued device & charger. If a student does not have a charger they will need to pay \$20.00 for the charger. Lost or missing devices will need to be paid for before getting their cap & gown.
- **Cap & Gown** Pick Up at end of practice any student who owes for AP tests, cafeteria fees, missing uniform fees, or cap & gown payments will need to pay those fees (in cash) to the Main Office before they can receive their cap & gown.

June 8th - Students report 10:00 AM -2:00 PM - report to the gym

- Yearbooks are distributed in the Hallway after practices.
- Senior Class Party at Swim Club
- 6:30 PM Senior Award winners report to Café dressed appropriately (no jeans, no shorts, no sneakers)
- 7:00 PM Scholarship and Awards Ceremony in the Auditorium please RSVP

June 9th – Students report to Auditorium at 7:40 AM – with Cap & Gown

- Administration will run through the Graduation Program with Seniors
- Class Officers, Advisors, and Stuco President will give their Farewell Addresses to the class
- Seniors will board the bus for their Community School
- Seniors will tour though their community school wearing their cap & gown
- Seniors will gather outside the community school to take a photograph
- Seniors will board back on the bus
- When Seniors return they will pick up their Graduation Tickets from the Table in the main lobby and are then dismissed. Every senior will receive 8 Graduation tickets. Students receive 8 tickets per family. Those who requested extra tickets and handicapped parking will

receive those at this time. Graduation speakers will remain for 45 minutes to practice their speeches/name calling in the Auditorium

Monday, June 12th – Students report directly to South Ave Field by 11:00 AM

- Seniors get seated (A-J Rights side Bleachers; K-Z left side bleachers) line up / walk onto field
- Admin will run through the program.
- Reminders at end of practice

Tuesday, June 13th – Graduation Day

- Graduates are to report to the High School Auditorium at 8:45 AM in cap & gown.
- **Dress Code for Graduates:** Smart Casual no shorts, no jeans, no sneakers, no flip flops. Students will be walking on grass and stones.
- **NO DECORATIONS on Graduation caps**. Decorated caps will be confiscated and replaced with a plain cap.
- No additions to the gown except for Honors Hoods and Cords provided by Interboro High School. Students may keep these items.
- **Gates will open at 9:00 AM.** This is a ticket only event. No Hillcrest entrance except for Handicapped parking (must have school issued handicapped parking pass).
- Graduation begins at 10:00 AM

Bleachers are divided by alphabet:

- Home Side Graduates Last Name A-J; Visitor Side Graduates Last Name K-Z.
- A bus will be available if parents want a ride from the HS to the field. (Bus Needed)
- Junior Class Congress will sell Water and Pretzels; Flowers and Spirit wear will be sold by an approved vendor

Rain – If it is raining in the AM – The Graduation may be pushed to 1:00 PM or 5:00 PM on June 13th. If the day is a washout, graduation will be held on June 14th at the South Ave Field. If neither date is possible because of rain – Graduation will be held in the Gym at 10:00 AM on June 14th and students will be given 2 tickets per family. Communication for rain delay will be sent through school email to families and graduates ASAP.
